6 tips for treating nature with respect

1 Whenever possible, travel in small groups to reduce the impact on the environment that you're exploring.

2 Take a map and compass so that you don't have to use marking paint, rocks or flagging to mark your path.

3 Camp at least 200 feet from lakes and streams to protect their banks.

4 Avoid bringing in or taking out any non-native species of plants or animals, including insects.

5 After a picnic, look around for any litter and be sure to pack out all trash and leftover food.

6 Stick to official trails or other legal areas to limit the spaces that are affected by human foot traffic.
